Minimum necessary data

In becoming a member of Sceptre Angling Club (hereafter call the SAC), the SAC will need to obtain and hold certain information about you. This information is needed to satisfy SAC administration details, insurance purposes, legal requirements, internal competitions and display of results. The minimum information requirements are:

- 1. Name
- 2. Address
- 2. Date of birth
- 4. Telephone No(s)
- E-mail address
- Membership of another club (if applicable)

This information will be stored either electronically or a hard copy as safely and securely as can be reasonably expected and will only be accessible in the strictest confidence to the SAC Committee in the fulfilment of their duties.
